



## Preschool Summer Session 2020 Information

Dear Preschool Families,

We are sending you this letter to announce our Preschool Summer Session for 2020. Our theme for this summer is **“Summer in the ‘Son’**”. We have an exciting summer program planned and we hope you decide to be a part of it! We will be doing fun summer activities that will allow your child to know the “Son”, who has a special plan and purpose for their life.

Summer session begins **Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup>** and goes through **Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>**.



**“June only” session includes 4 weeks:** June 1<sup>st</sup> through June 26<sup>th</sup>.

**“July only” session includes 4 weeks:** June 29<sup>th</sup> through July 24<sup>th</sup>.

**“Whole summer” session includes all 8 weeks:** June 1<sup>st</sup> through July 24<sup>th</sup>.

### What to bring:

- **All children** need a change of clothes placed in a Ziploc bag with your child’s name printed on it. This will remain at school for the duration of Summer Camp. Please replenish as necessary. All children must wear proper shoes during Summer Camp. We prefer closed-toe shoes for safety. **No flip flop style sandals are permitted.**
- **Full day students** need to bring a fitted crib sheet and a small blanket for nap. Please write your child’s name on these items and take them home weekly for laundering. A WOL nap bag is provided to new full day students to transport nap items. Please no backpacks.
- **Please note that our school is a nut free facility.**



### New CDC Safe Practices:

- We will be adhering to a strict 10:1 student to teacher ratio in all classrooms.
- A temperature scan and health check will be conducted on each student and staff member upon arrival every day. Please allow yourself extra time during drop-off to accommodate health screening time. You may have to wait for other students to be screened, please practice social distancing if waiting for the health screening table to become available. Temperatures will be monitored throughout the day as needed.
- Handwashing is required by students and staff throughout the day, both scheduled and as needed. Student handwashing is overseen to encourage proper handwashing techniques. *Please note: Community Care Licensing considers hand sanitizer a “keep out of reach of children” item. Please do not send your child to school with hand sanitizer.*
- Toys and educational materials will be sanitized after each use. Classrooms and restrooms will be sanitized daily as well as throughout the day as needed.
- In an effort to keep our school environment as safe and sanitary as possible, we request that adults wear a mask during drop-off and pick-up. As to not introduce outside contagions to the classrooms, all students will be escorted to and from their classroom during drop-off and pick-up by a staff member.
- If your student begins showing any symptoms of illness, they will be isolated from other students immediately. It is required that the student be picked up within 30 minutes of notification of symptoms. If you need to update your phone number or pick-up list, please contact the school office.

**Drop-off time:** 6:30AM to 8:30AM (*half day and full day*)

**Pick-up time:** 12:30PM (*half day*), 2:30PM to 6:00PM (*full day*)
